He is a Clinical Associate Professor in the Department of Implant Dentistry, Director of the Advanced CDE Program in Aesthetic Dentistry at New York University College of Dentistry and Prosthodontic Section Editor for PPAD [Practical Procedures and Aesthetic Dentistry, Montage Media Corp.].

Dr. Larry Rosenthal heads the Rosenthal/Apa Group for Aesthetic Dentistry in New York City where he maintains his Aesthetic and Restorative dental practice. In the early 90s, Dr. Rosenthal developed the “Smile Lift.” He presented a paper that demonstrated he could transform a patient’s smile via minimally invasive techniques and improve his/her health and function. Dr. Rosenthal has placed more than 40,000 porcelain laminate veneers dating back to the early 80s. He is a pioneer in Cosmetic Dentistry and has published, lectured, and demonstrated both nationally and internationally. Dr. Rosenthal is an accredited member of the American Academy of Cosmetic Dentistry. He is Director of the Aesthetic Continuum at The Advanced Aesthetic Program at New York University, London and Palm Beach, Florida. These programs are hands-on and have taught his philosophy and technique to thousands of dentists worldwide. He has been profiled on television, radio, and in such leading publications as Vogue, Town & Country, W, Elle, Glamour, Forbes, The New York Times, and the Wall Street Journal. He is on the advisory board of numerous companies and is on the editorial board of Compendium’s CERP.



Dr. Jay Lerner graduated from Columbia University School of Dentistry in 1982 and completed a General Practice residency at Brookdale Medical Center in New York. He has been in private practice in Palm Beach Gardens, Florida since 1983. His practice focuses on comprehensive restorative and aesthetic dentistry. Dr. Lerner is dedicated to continuing education, having completed advanced training in aesthetic and restorative dentistry at Baylor College of Dentistry, New York University, The Seattle Institute, and The Dawson Center. He has studied with Frank Spear and Peter Dawson and incorporates their philosophy in his practice and teachings. He serves as a senior clinical instructor with the Rosenthal Institute at New York University, Indiana University, the Eastman Dental Clinic in London, England, and the Palm Beach Community College in West Palm Beach. He is also the Chairman of the Comprehensive Esthetic and Restorative Clinic at the Atlantic Coast Dental Research Clinic in West Palm Beach.
